

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING
Minutes for May 28, 1986

The meeting was called to order by Vice President Bill, N6FAB.

Present were: Bill, N6FAB; Jim, WA6RZA; Jack, K6ZMA; Barry, KE6LW; Ron, WB5FIX and Ron, KB6LTJ.

The May 31 "Fund Run" in Sutter County was discussed, and it appears the club will provide communications for the event. Our participation will be limited to only communications, with no responsibility for traffic control and such things.

Field Day was then discussed. Main topic was the need of a second generator for the Novice/Technician and 160-meter stations. A unit of 750 watts or greater capability is required. Another item discussed was that Deane, NR6A, will not be able to be present on Saturday. This will require an alternate for the 75-meter position. The Board requested that anyone willing to commit gear, time or whatever, contact either Loyd, WA6AGD or Bill, N6FAB.

The Board has been advised that the ARRL Section Manager would like to have a meeting in this area July 12, 1986. Lenore, KA6UBI, has agreed to provide a place for the gathering. It was decided that the club expense for the meeting should be held to an absolute minimum. Therefore, the members are to bring their own steak, chicken, hamburger or other main dish. We will go potluck on salads and desserts, and the club will provide soda pop and coffee. There will be a donation can available to help defray club costs. This will be the club meeting for the month of July.

Main reason for concern on expenses is that the period of income is past, and the club has \$409.00 in the treasury for the remainder of the year. This must cover Field Day expenses as well as paper, labels and postage for the newsletter.

In response to a request from our duplicator of the club newsletter, the Board agreed to buy paper and labels for the newsletter. A supply for over a year is estimated to cost about \$50.00. A bill for the exact amount will be presented at the next Board meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was then adjourned.
