

"HAM" TERM STORY REFUTED!
Recently we've seen quite a spread of a story telling how we all got to be called hams. It deals with an early Harvard University amateur station with the callsign

HAM. According to the story, before the regulations for amateur radio were written in 1912, this "station" was the enterprise of three students, whose initials were H, A, and M. Also part of this tale is the supposed testimony before Congress by one of the lads which led to the establishment of codified amateur rules and regulations. WIRW, John Huntoon, has refuted the story, and points out its many flaws and inconsistencies. He says there are no facts to back it up. No Congressional Record entry exists regarding this story. Senator Walsh was not a senator until 10 years later. The Harvard Radio Club never heard of the people who supposedly started it all in 1912. If you see this story in any of a number of newsletters, just remember, it has been refuted over the years almost every time it has appeared.

NEW HAM STUFF:

The Grove Enterprises catalog has a couple of wild new radios. The AOR AR1000XC is a handheld scanner that covers 500kHz to 1.3 GHz. It receives AM/FM-wide/FM narrow modes and has a tuning knob for up/down frequency adjustments as well as the key pad. It will store 1000 memory channels and scan 20 channels per second. Audio output is 400 milliwatts.

Also in the Grove catalog is the new AOR AR2000 total coverage scanner with SSB. This is a base/mobile unit that does all the same things as the AR1000XC. The most amazing thing about both of these receivers is the price--\$399. Electronics in general keep coming down in price with more features being added all the time.

Yet another entry in the scanner category I've seen recently is an \$800 wide range scanner that has a spectrum display on the front panel along with the frequency readout. This is one of those bells and whistles features that I've always been intrigued by, even if it is of limited utility.

While scanners don't fall into just the ham stuff file, they have become part of everyone's station. Wide frequency coverage is a prime concern. Which leads us to....

Randy, KC6MUS, and Gary, N6YCH, may have a surprise nod for us at the meeting on Saturday. Delving into an otherwise ok Yaesu FT-470, they may be able to have a Quad Band transceiver, with appropriate antennae of course. Or they may have expensive lumps of non-functional electronics to show us. Come on over and enjoy the thrill of victory, or the joy of seeing one who has been defeated by electron magic!

**JUST NEWS ...from ARRL'S LETTER
DL CALL SIGN CHANGES**

Amateurs from the former East Germany are in the process of having their call signs changed to those with DL prefixes. This will take place over the next few months. The ITU has asked Germany to relinquish the Y2-Y9 call sign block next year, for reallocation to another country.

US-PHILIPPINES AGREEMENT

Remember when the earthquake and volcano disasters hit the P.I. and we couldn't send health and welfare messages there because of a third party traffic restriction? Well...the governments of the Philippines and the U.S. entered into an agreement effective June 4th permitting the exchange of messages on behalf of third parties. Such messages must be made in plain language and shall be limited to messages of a technical nature and to remarks of personal character for which, by reason of their unimportance, recourse to the public telecommunications service is not justified--except when the immediate

safety of life or the immediate protection of property is involved.

AMATEUR RADIO AWARENESS DAY

Amateur Radio Public Awareness Day will be held September 7. To make the public more aware of the existence, purposes, and benefits of Amateur Radio, clubs and individuals will set up and operate across the nation in schools, libraries, town halls, parks, fairs and anywhere else an imaginative club can think of. We should start planning our club's public exhibit now. ARRL HQ will help, but we need volunteers.

CALIFORNIA PIRATE, QRT

The FCC's Los Angeles Office shut down an unlicensed radio station operating on 89.7 MHz in Simi Valley, CA. Derek Lloyd Underhill was fined \$1000 for unlicensed operation. Unlicensed "KDLU" caused interference to a licensed station operating on a nearby frequency.

Of course, unlicensed operation is a violation of section 301 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. Sanctions may include administrative fines of up to \$10,000 and/or criminal penalties of up to \$100,000 and/or imprisonment for up to one year.

OHIO TOWER VICTORY

After four years and a federal lawsuit, Jim MacMillan, WABZHN, has installed his 3 element yagi atop a 30 foot mast in Rocky River, Ohio. MacMillan sued the city when its Board of Zoning (BZA) refused to grant him a permit for a tower. The US District Court Judge ordered the city to reconsider the application, taking into account FCC regulation PRB-1.

The court ruled that the BZA clearly ignored PRB-1 and that it would hold the board members personally liable if they continued to deny a permit without a compelling reason. The city hired two real estate appraisers who agreed that MacMillan's antenna would have no adverse effect on neighborhood property values. ARRL volunteer counsel Bob Winston, W2THU, represented MacMillan. Winston noted that "This must be the shortest tower ever litigated."

The city of Rocky River was required to pay Winston's attorney fees.

HR 73 JOINED BY S 1372

Remember the House of Representatives bill which sought to hold onto spectrum for hams instead of seeing it all sold to the highest commercial bidder. That is HR 73, and as this is being written, Rep. Berger's office still doesn't know if Wally will support this bill. In the senate, thanks to Al Gore, we have Senate Bill 1372, which seeks to do the same thing. Get in touch with our Senators and Wally. Let them know you are interested in keeping our operating space. We need their votes!
